- Displays a genuine commitment to our programs and organizations.
- Must demonstrate a friendly, warm and welcoming attitude.
- Supports the Norwich Family YMCA in all programs and developments.
- Must be a positive role model.
- Outstanding contribution in the area of volunteerism.
