During the calendar year of 2020, we experienced many challenges that we have never faced as an organization before. A global pandemic closed our doors for six months, New York State limited our reopening and occupancy to 33% for eleven months, and during this time we lost 2,000 members.

Limited staffing, adjusted hours and financial uncertainty provided a backdrop of the unknown. With the support of our community and membership we were able to create a plan that allowed us to continue providing essential childcare to countless families in need last year. We continue to partner with our friends with "Helping Hands" in supporting our community in need with food and household good donations.

This past year, we experienced an amazing amount of generosity, supporting our YMCA. Over 200 donors supported "The Open Doors Scholarship Campaign", many unrestricted donations, corporate donations supporting special events and programs, our spring "Send a kid to Camp" and the many in- kind donations directly benefitted us.

A very unique donation scenario occurred with the Norwich High School Class of 1960 decided to raise funds to benefit four selected local charities. The four community charities were Dollars for Scholars, the Norwich Food Bank (Roots and Wings), the relatively new Improve Norwich Now, and the YMCA Open Doors Scholarship campaign. Donations were generously given by many classmates from across the country. A total of \$10,180 was raised and was divided equally among the four charities resulting in \$2,545 gift going to each organization in memory of the Class.

Many have decided to use the Y Campaign as an opportunity to recognize, memorialize and honor their family and friends. This is evident within our year-end report that you are reading. The Class of 1960 gift and the many other names were recognized and were honored this year.

Thank you for your unwavering support and your willingness to support us during our most challenging time. Your generosity has allowed us to continue being a "hands on" engaging organization, while providing meaningful programs to our community.
